

Amendment 1 to Freight RFP USAID Prepo for WFP Yemen 40,000 Metric Tons of Bulk Soft White Wheat
USAID Freight RFP No. AC20-0037 and AC20-0038 Dated April 13, 2020.

The following amendment is made to the referred Freight RFP:

(3) Discharge port: 1 to 2 safe berths each, 1 to 3 safe ports, out of Aden, Yemen at USAID charterer's, option discharge at Port Saleef, Yemen and or charterer's option Hodeidah, Yemen, and or charterer's option Jebel Ali, UAE, and or charterer's option Salalah, Oman, and or charterer's option Port Sudan, Sudan, and or charterer's option Djibouti, Djibouti, and or charterer's option Berbera, Somalia and or charterer's option Mombasa, Kenya.

Intended discharge ports for the two cargoes:

20,000 MT for April 28-May 8, 2020 laydays – Intention Aden, Yemen.

20,000 MT for April 28-May 8, 2020 laydays – Intention Aden, Yemen.

The above shipments are not combinable. Each to be shipped separately.

Offers must include all ports listed above in their proposals. Exclusion of any named port(s) will result in the Offer being deemed non-responsive.

Charterers to nominate final discharge port(s)/rate(s) latest upon passing Strait of Messina southbound, or upon passing Colombo westbound for shipments from USA West Coast.

Freight offers shall be evaluated basis the Free Out option freight rate to the intended discharge port / per lot.

Owners to satisfy themselves on the prevailing restrictions at all load and discharge port(s) and Charterers are not responsible for any failure thereto.

Transshipment is prohibited.

All other terms and conditions of the Freight RFP remain unchanged.
