SUBJECT: Intent to Consolidate Global Health Institutional Support Services

This letter serves as notification in accordance with FAR 7.107-5(b), Notification to public of rationale for bundled requirement, of the U.S. Agency for International Development, Bureau for Global Health's (GH) intent to consolidate and bundle institutional support services for the GH offices that support the technical and programmatic needs of USAID's global health efforts around the world.

- AIDOAAC1600031 (Global Health Support Initiative III)
- AID-OAA-M-16-00011 (Global Health Professional and Organizational Development II (GHPOD-II))
- 7200AA18C00096 (Global Health Technical Professionals (GHTP))

GH's ISC mechanisms have seen significant growth in both size and scope in the last ten years. These contracts will be consolidated under the Global Health Training, Advisory, and Support Contract (GHTASC) solicitation. The measurably substantial benefits that are expected to accrue from this consolidation are as follows:

- Cost savings in an amount greater than \$9.4 million (see FAR 7.107);
- Efficiencies gained from the use of a single mechanism;
- Economies of scale;
- Improve contractor employee equity;
- Avoidance of duplicative efforts; and
- Reduction in Government administrative costs.

Currently, the GHPOD-II contract is the only small business performing services on the separate contracts to be consolidated. This consolidation streamlines the efforts of the GH workforce development and institutional support services.
